The Suffolk Center on the Holocaust, Diversity & Human Understanding, Inc. has created an exhibit based upon the rare, historic book, *Extermination of Polish Jews: Album of Pictures*. The book made its journey to the United States with the Charych family. Henia and Alex Charych acquired it when it was published soon after liberation. While they had survived, they were the exceptions in their respective families. Their children now live on Long Island and in California. The story of their parents' survival is also told by this exhibit.

A reception and program for the exhibit will feature the co-authors of *Children of Terror*. Written by Inge Auerbacher of Jamaica, NY and Bozenna Urbanowicz Gilbride of Southampton, NY, it tells the story of two young girls, born the same year, one a Catholic from Poland, the other a Jew from Germany, each a witness to the Holocaust, each living in concentration camps. They will recount their moving testimony and be available to sign their book.
